US politician who recently died in 2020. Led many non-violent protests such as "sit-ins" involving students.



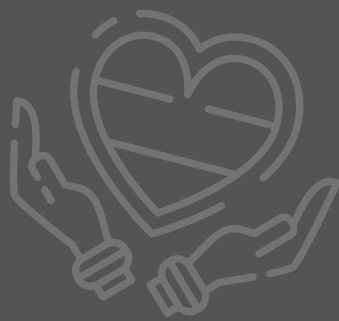
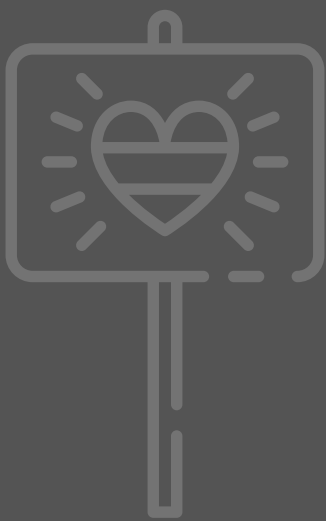
Shirley Chisholm:

Ruby Bridges:

In 1960, she was the first African-American girl to integrate into a southern elementary school at the age of six.
